



Use of EREA Facilities by Third Parties Policy

Approved by the EREA Board: 24 June 2014

Rationale:	There is a need for processes to be in place for the use of EREA facilities by third parties which includes schools and EREA offices. Each EREA school and office has its own processes for the use of their facilities in accord with their particular location context.
Principles:	EREA operates within the context of the Charter which is underpinned by EREA core values. EREA is committed to sharing its resources wherever and whenever practicable.
Policy Statement:	All EREA facilities shall be used to further the mission of EREA, including to facilitate community engagement. Facilities may be used for non-mission work, to generate financial returns to a school, as long as the purpose the facility is used for it is not in conflict with EREA's mission.
Applicable to:	All EREA schools and offices.
Key Responsibilities:	The Executive Director has responsibility for the implementation of this policy and to oversee the development of procedures and/or guidelines for the use of EREA schools and office facilities.
Effective From:	24 June 2014
Review:	Consideration will be given every 2 years to determine if this policy requires review earlier than 2018.
