



Code of Conduct Policy

Approved by the EREA Board: 24 June 2014

Rationale:	The Code of Conduct Policy sets out the minimum standards of behaviour and expectations held by Edmund Rice Education Australia (EREA) for all persons within the EREA community in the performance of their duties. It gives guidance in areas where personal and ethical decisions need to be made. There are relevant Codes of Conduct for each specific group.
Principles:	The welfare of those who govern, work and who are in our care is of paramount importance and as such EREA Codes of Conduct reflect the Charter and are underpinned by EREA core values.
Policy Statement:	All members of the EREA Council, EREA Board and EREA employees and volunteers are expected to adhere to the relevant Codes of Conduct.
Applicable to:	Members of the EREA Council, EREA Board and all EREA employees and volunteers.
Key Responsibilities:	The President of the EREA Council, the Chair of the EREA Board and the Executive Director of EREA have the responsibility for the implementation of this policy.
Review:	Consideration will be given every 2 years to determine if this policy requires review earlier than 2018.
